

INTEGRATION PROGRAM FOR NEW-TO-FRENCH STUDENTS

This program is aiming at new-to-French children for an admission from CP to CM2 (from year 1 to year 5 of elementary school) in September 2023.

What is the integration program about?

Our goal is to give the students the ability to follow the class in French in the École française de Sharmel Sheikh (EFSSH) within 6 months.

- Students will be assessed for their skills in non-linguistic subjects.
- Students will follow a course for non-French speaking pupils with a teacher who is specialized in teaching French as a foreign language. These hours are not spent with the other students of the ordinary class but are specifically designed for non-French speaking children according to their language level.
- Students will participate to the courses with the students of their age in the ordinary classes for one and a half hour to two hours every day during school time.
- Students will follow the Extra Curricular Activity after 3pm (compulsory attendance with an additional cost for the families) at least 4 hours per week.
- Students will take part in visits and school trips with the classes of the school.
- According to their progress, the students will spend gradually more and more time in the regular class. The course in the integration class cannot exceed one school year.

- Provide documents on the child's identity and educational background, for the school's records **before June 15th**. Once parents have applied, students will be called in for a morning of observation.
- Families will be charged for this registration and pay the school fees of the class corresponding to the child's age. (Schoolfees can be downloaded on the website)
- During the morning of observation, students will be assessed according to their language, mathematics and general skills following their age level.
- Then, a meeting between the families and the school headmaster will be set to clarify the enrollment project.
- If the enrollment is accepted by the headmaster, the child will join the integration class at the beginning of September. The student will then be enroled at EFSSH.
- To finalize the enrolment, families will have secure the payment of the initial enrolment fees and the school deposit. In the event of a non-validation of an application, the fees will be fully reimbursed.
